Most people have a ghost story. But how many people have the evidence to prove it? “My Ghost Story 2: Hauntings Revealed,” the second Bio Channel special, showcases unbelievable stories of the paranormal told by the people who lived through them and captured their hauntings on film. Premiering Saturday, July 11th at 10PM ET/11PM PT on BIO, these harrowing eye-witness accounts of the unexplainable are transformed into more than just tales. From moving furniture, to dark apparitions, to violent poltergeists, In “My Ghost Story,” viewers will have to decide for themselves whether or not to believe their own eyes.

Cases featured:

THE GHOST TOWN REAPER:

A bizarre haunting at an abandoned 1860’s California mining town is captured on film by Mark, a wedding photographer who is attempting to document deserted towns for a book. When Mark sees a mist form into the shape of a grim reaper like image he snaps five extraordinary pictures that are the epitome of creepy. This is the first time that Mark and his assistant Philip have come forward to discuss this haunting and show their evidence.

POSSESSION IN THE HEARTLAND:

Tony and Debra Pickman truly lived in a haunted house, in Atchison, Kansas. An entity in the house took possession of Tony throwing him to the floor on numerous occasions, and for a period of over six months scratched him bloody hundreds of times, producing an enormous wealth of photographic and video evidence. Furthermore extraordinary ghostly images were captured outside the windows and dark gooey blobs appear in pictures of their child’s room.

ATTACK OF THE PHANTOM:

When Cloe attends a Stephen King conference at the legendary Stanley Hotel in Estes, Colorado she has no idea that she'll become the victim of an unseen phantom. The haunting starts in her hotel room when it locks her out of her room, rearranges her clothes and opens and closes doors. In a nearby hallway she is literally shoved by an unseen hand and has her back scratched – which is caught on tape. She later learns that a maid had died in her room many years ago.

HAUNTED PLANTATION:

The Myrtles Plantation is a bed and breakfast hotel and known to be one of the most haunted places in America. When Francis Entienne stays for a few days she hears voices and is touched by an entity. She takes it upon herself to shoot some video tape one evening and catches some extraordinary images of apparitions floating above the garden and floating orbs and mists in one of the rooms. The floating image resembles a man's upper body carrying a torch or candelabra.

TABITHA'S GHOST:

After Tabitha passes away due to leukemia, her best friend and neighbor Kim begins to notice strange occurrences taking place in her home. It is Christmas time and Tabitha's children continue to play with Kim's children. Toys move on their own, lights flash on and off and strange orbs begin showing up on photographs of the kids. It gets to the point where Kim, and her husband, Paul, can conjure up mists of orbs by calling out Tabitha's name. Kim and Paul capture these extraordinary orb images on video tape.

CIVIL WAR GHOSTS:

Civil war buff Tom Underwood has visited many Civil War battle sites. On one occasion while attending a battle re-enactment at Gettysburg with his wife Delia and their young son, he captures on video tape ghostly images of soldiers moving through the woods next to the battlefield. Then Tom's camera captures the flashing lights of musket and gun fire coming from the seemingly empty woods. Included in the storytelling is some extraordinary footage of a Battle of Gettysburg re-enactment.
